### **Golf Update:**

Maintenance crews have been extremely busy throughout the month of June with recent rains that continue to keep the courses green and the grass growing. No major disease outbreaks so far this season. The annual bluegrass is starting to show some stress and would expect it to expire before too long.

Crews continue to work on irrigation issues at each course and repairs are almost constantly ongoing. Example Pioneers had 3 leaks in one day that had to be repaired before going forward with other important timely tasks.

Our sand supplier has the correct sand now for topdressing greens. With the heavy rains and flooding this spring the supplier couldn't produce the proper sand for topdressing greens and sanding had to be delayed. With the correct sand now being available greens will get back on schedule.

June golf rounds and June sales are just slightly behind average due to a few days of rainfall washing out carts and rounds through June 21<sup>st</sup>. Forecast for final week of June looks like drier weather which will bring in more revenue to end month.

### **Player Development Update:**

Some new events at Mahoney have increased traffic to the course in last few weeks. Glow Night putting, Couples, and Mahomies Nights have events coming up in July & Aug.

Youth/Adult Golf event in mid-July at the Ager course is always a well-attended.
