### **Golf Update:**

With the heat and humidity come increased labor expenses and material costs. Irrigation remains a struggle at each of the courses. 10 inch main line at Mahoney and joint failures at others. A large pump and motor failure at Highlands. Fortunately we have three large motors and pumps at that location and are able to keep water running.

With hot and dry conditions courses have been forced to run additional irrigation programs to keep grass alive. Dead or brown areas in fairways indicate annual poa dying off much like any other summer. With August soon to come please keep in mind most of our unclassified help will be returning to school. This means some tasks will be delayed until time permits.

New Heights Tree service should be back to Mahoney very soon to finish the tree project.

June was a solid month for golf revenues. Expenses for the month came in under budget. With the poor winter and wet spring weather setting revenues back, the last 3 months have seen a positive trend with more golf rounds being played than budgeted.
