### **Golf Update:**

July was a typical month for rounds of golf and revenues generated. Saw a slight hot streak of temperatures that slowed golfer rounds for a few days. Utility expenses are still lower than budgeted due to timely rains during the month and year. Some part time help have headed back to school and staffs will stretched to achieve certain tasks in a timely manner. Please have patience during the fall months and we will do our best to keep up. Staff will be over seeding some fairways and tee boxes going into fall. Greens aeration begins with Mahoney on August 26 & 27 followed by Highlands on September 9 & 10 – Holmes on September 16 & 17 – Pioneer September 23 & 24.

Irrigation repairs continue to be problematic and expensive throughout the month of August.

Tree/Brush piles at Mahoney have been cleaned up.

At Highlands a new jockey and large pump and motors have been replaced. This will leave one more large pump and motor to replace next fiscal year then entire pump station will be in good running order at Highlands.

### **Player Development Update:**

Summer programs have wrapped up with outstanding numbers once again. Fall youth leagues have filled all 72 spots. Fall youth learning camps have registered 138 golfers of the 140 spots available this fall with another week left for registering.
