Golf Update:

Golf rounds for June were 16.6% above targeted rounds so for the third month in a row actual rounds exceeded target rounds. A few golf tournaments have kicked off in late June and more are scheduled for July and August. Revenues were steady again for the month of June.

Golf courses have seen numerous trees damaged and lost from storms this past month. The rains have been a blessing and courses are staying in good shape heading into the “Dog Days” of summer.

Crews have been keeping up with growth regulator applications on greens along with rolling/topdressing and protective plant applications. As we have seen in the past as it heats up and humidity increases the fungus will start showing up on fairways and tees. Driving ranges have seen more traffic this season and with that comes the inevitable damage to turf. Crews spend time each week reseeding areas/sections on driving ranges in an attempt to keep some turfgrass on the tee to hit from. This season has been especially challenging. Some native areas around the courses have been mowed to keep the weeds and woody plants from taking over. We would like to start looking at recapturing the “Native” areas around Pioneer beginning this fall and winter.
