Golf Update:

November has been an interesting month. Cold then warm and windy then cold again and back to a few warm days here and there. Hope everyone has had an opportunity to get out and play some golf in between the weather ups and downs. Golf maintenance staffs have been busy with getting golf carts serviced and putting together needed parts lists for golf carts and equipment prior to really digging in on preventive maintenance work this winter. Did you know that 90% of our cart and equipment maintenance is done “In-House” by our maintenance staffs? By having such a talented staff we are able to save thousands of dollars each winter. With the nice weather the staffs have been busy working on leaf control as best as possible along with topdressing greens, fall fertilizer applications and weed control. Tree removal continues as time allows. Pioneer, Mahoney and Holmes all have a number of dead or dying pine trees that will need removed. Unfortunately Mahoney has experienced a number of pine trees actually blowing over and those have been cleaned up. Crews will continue to be re-planting trees throughout the golf courses in the future. The irrigation design for Pioneer golf course has been completed and we will be posting the design soon at each golf course. The irrigation systems have been long overdue for replacement and this should be a good start to investing in our city golf program so we can continue to share these beautiful course with our golfing public for many more years to come.

Golf rounds for October were 37.3% above target with 15,089 rounds played in the month. Overall the year to date rounds are ahead of year to date targeted golf rounds with two months played. November weather looks promising to hit the goal for this month as well so should have three months of golf rounds ahead of target. We are heading into our slowest months for golf rounds with were typically only about 3% of the rounds for the year get played in December, January and February months due to winter.
