### **Golf Update:**

December brought on a few weeks of above normal temperatures and the month ended with 3,119 golf rounds played. The target goal for the month was 1,618. This marks the fourth consecutive month that actual golf rounds have surpassed budgeted golf rounds. Golf rounds for the fiscal year thru December are currently 53.1% ahead of target. Looking ahead January and February are typically the slowest months for golf rounds due to snowfall and cold temperatures.

The Clancy Woolman clubhouse at Highlands is undergoing a few projects this winter. The ceiling around the sky light needed expansion joints and drywall replacement along with crack and joint repairs. Estimated cost \$13,000. The floor replacement and remodel to the restrooms including fixtures is under way. Old carpet was 28 years old that is being removed. New carpet will be carpet squares which are much easier to replace. Project is estimated to cost about \$49,000 and should be completed by early February. There will be a couple of days in this project where Highlands will need to be closed temporarily.

On the maintenance side of things the typical seasonal maintenance on golf course equipment continues along with tree work at the courses. Most of the trees are dead or dying pine trees being removed.

Ash tree removal will continue at Holmes golf course this winter and if the weather allows this will finish up our ash tree removal there. Ash tree removal at Pioneer golf course has been completed. Our goal would be to finish up ash tree removal at Mahoney golf course in 2022. Discussion with staff on the replacement of the entire Pioneers Irrigation system along with gathering information from outside sources on Pioneers hole #5 fairway in regard to water runoff/drainage on the fairway.

### **Player Development Update:**

Golf classes for 2021 including adult, teen, and juniors have all been scheduled and are now open for registration. Typically late spring is when classes start to fill up with the warmer temperatures on the horizon.
