### **Golf Update:**

March saw above average number of golf rounds despite some cooler weather in the month. March had 11,841 golf rounds played which was 52.8% above the targeted number of golf rounds. So far in April the weekend weather has been nice which has helped keep the number of golf rounds above average thru the first half of the month.

The greens aeration has gone great at Pioneer, Mahoney and Holmes up to this point. Highlands aerates April 26<sup>th</sup> & 27<sup>th</sup>. The last of the three pumps and motors at Highlands pump house have been replaced and is now up and running. Highlands new irrigation controllers will soon be getting installed to gain better control of the irrigation. Other irrigation pipe issues have been primarily at Pioneer and Holmes with several pipe joint breaks at Holmes. Crews are still working at dead pine tree removal and we have been working on stump removals this week. The recent cool weather has slowed mowing to a degree and crews have capitalized on finishing up those late winter early spring projects. The irrigation plan for Pioneer is now at 100% complete and after a last review we will be getting that project out to bid. At some point soon for planning purposes we would like to visit with the Golf Facilities Committee regarding the bunkers at Holmes and planning for possible removals or rebuilds.

### **Player Development Update:**

Adult Golf 101 and Golf 201 classes kicked off last week and this week. The four spring sessions of adult golf classes were all sold out. Spring youth golf leagues and golf camps have started with good participation numbers for spring. Zac Morley the new player development supervisor for Lincoln Golf is getting settled into his new role and things are going well.
